Important Information Regarding Archdiocesan Assessments

Assessments are amounts charged to our parish by the Archdiocese. In effect, they are like a tax. With each new fiscal year, our parish is assessed new amounts.

Each parishioner receives envelopes specifically designated for these expenses. Donations in the designated envelopes are accepted at any time throughout the year, however some assessments are collected at specific times. For example, the Catholic Charities collection is collected at Christmas and the Priesthood: Past & Future (which does not support the monks of St. Benedict's Abbey) is collected at Easter. Any amounts collected in the designated envelopes from parishioners toward these assessments lessen the financial burden of the parish, but **DO NOT** directly support parish operations.

As we have just begun a new fiscal year, please note below the new assessment amounts that will be due this year.
